City of Unalaska Legislative Report

3/5/21

There were several hearings scheduled this past week, even with absent legislators and staff due to quarantine. Governor Dunleavy continues to keep a low profile since it was announced last week that he had tested positive for COVID-19.

On a bright note, Senate Concurrent Resolution 1 (SCR1) which would suspend uniform rules for legislative business and allow voting by videoconference was accelerated this week. The resolution passed the Senate 19-0 on February 3rd and was given two committees of referral by the House. After positive COVID-19 cases disrupted legislative business last week, this week the House removed both committees from the resolution, and it is now in House Rules awaiting floor action. This is an important move that will hopefully provide for more efficient legislative business during the pandemic.

The Senate finance subcommittees continue to progress with the House carrying out their initial finance subcommittee work. Some Senate finance subcommittees are publicly noticing closeouts as early as this coming week, consistent with the Senate's projected schedule for completion in mid-March. The standing finance committees cannot start actively working on the budget until the subcommittees have completed their work and submitted recommendations.

The standing Senate and House finance committees continue working through overviews and presentations related to the Governor's proposed budget with many questions to the Director of the Office of Management and Budget, Neil Stieninger and Lucinda Mahoney, the Commissioner of Department of Revenue.

Commissioner Mahoney took some tough questions regarding the Governor's proposed spending of more than \$3.2 billion beyond what was planned from permanent fund earnings and his position on putting any new broad-based tax and changes to the PFD formula to a vote of the people. Specifically, in regard to the timing which does not work in relation to balancing the budget.

Mahoney stated the state would draw more from permanent fund earnings until spending and revenue were in balance. The Legislature's nonpartisan budget experts have said that without changes, the state government could spend down the roughly \$15 billion earnings reserve.

Finance experts have pointed out that every dollar taken from the fund beyond what's planned will reduce the fund's earnings forever. For example, the annual earnings growth lost from an unplanned \$3.2 billion draw at 5% growth would be \$160 million.

There were concerns surrounding the senecio if the voters reject both a proposed new tax and lower dividends.

The good news is that the price of oil is up which should help some with the deficit.

HB76, the house version of a disaster relief extension bill, was heard in House HSS on Tuesday and Thursday, and is noticed for hearings on Tuesday, 3/9/21 at 3PM and then noticed in House Finance on Thursday, 3/11/21 “pending referral” signaling an interest in moving the bill forward. The most recent version includes extension language until September 2021, an also adopted language around informed consent, ability to deny vaccine for religious, medical or spiritual purposes, liability issues about dates, and recognition of the legislature’s best interest to continue to allow vaccines to be administered. It also addressed that the Governor may only appropriate funds that are in HB76. While no action has occurred on the senate version, SB56, the bill continues to be a vehicle for action.

SB15, penalties for opens meetings act violations was heard and held a second time in Senate Community and Regional Affairs on Thursday, March 4th. A committee substitute was adopted that clarified the role of the Alaska Public Offices Commission (APOC) as the enforcement entity, adopted a fine of \$1000 for violations, and clarified the definitions of “knowingly” and “public official”. The bill is scheduled for another hearing in this committee on Tuesday at 3:30 PM allowing for public testimony.

Senator Reinbold held a press conference on Thursday morning, requesting that the Governor retract his recent letter indicating her requests for access to the executive branch would no longer be honored, and requested a public apology.

Senator Begich introduced SB 100, State Income Tax, on Friday. The bill was referred to Senate State Affairs and Finance.

The Senate GO Bond bill (SB74) was heard and held in the Senate Transportation committee on Tuesday. The hearing was primarily a bill overview, however, there were discussion about the need for GO bonds if the State is anticipating a healthy sum from the federal government in the form of an infrastructure bill, possibly in the \$850 M range. Senator Kiehl also questioned the bills legitimacy due to the single subject rule and verified that in essence we are “borrowing the state match for federal funding”. Senator Kiehl indicated that he may have an AG opinion to provide in relation to the single subject rule. SB74 will be taken up again next Tuesday.

HB 30, Workers Compensation death and partial impairment, was heard on Wednesday, this bill is sponsored by Rep. Josephson and is the same bill he has sponsored the last couple sessions, minus the death benefit payout that he had originally advocated for.

HB 104, Motor Fuel Tax, was heard in the House Transportation Committee on Thursday. This bill is essentially the same bill that Senator Bishop was sponsoring last session. The bill was heard and set aside, it is not scheduled for additional consideration at this point.
